An anyone who has had the chance to drive by or visit the cemetery lately has probably noticed how much cleaner and weed free Glen View is.

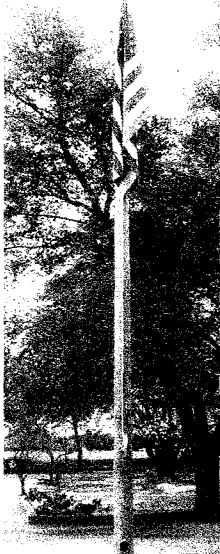


Some visitors around
